One of the facts of Einstein's theory of relativity is that time is not absolute. This means that time does not process at the same rate for everyone. For example, time seems to tick slower to a person on a spaceship travelling close to the speed of light where the observer back on earth, time ticks a lot faster.

Atomic clocks use the principles of quantum mechanics to measure time more accurately than anything else. The most accurate atomic clock that's ever built is a Strontium clock from the NIST (National Institute of Standard and Technology) & the University of Colorado Boulder.

It is accurate that it will not lose or gain a second in 15 billion years! Such atomic clocks could also be linked to a global network which can be used to measure time independent of location.

THE STEM CELL BIOTECHNOLOGY

Stem cell biotechnology is a field of biotechnology that develops tools and therapeutics through modification and engineering of stem cells. Stem cell biotechnology is important in regenerative medicine stem cells are actually body's raw materials cells from which all other cells with specialized functions are generated under the right conditions in the body or a laboratory, stem cells divide to form more cells become either new stem cells or specialized cells with a more specific function, such as blood cells, brain cells, heart muscle cells or bone cells. No other cell in the body.

These stem cells come from embryos that are 3 to 5 days old. At this stage, an embryo is called blastocyst and has about 150 cells. These are pluripotent and this versatility allows embryonic stem cells to be used to regenerate or repair diseased tissue and organs. These stem cells are found in small numbers in most adult tissues, such as bone marrow or fat. Compared with embryonic stem cells, adult stem cells have more limited ability to give rise to various cells of the body. Researches have discovered stem cells in amniotic fluid as well as in umbilical cord blood.

Amniotic fluid fills the sac that surrounds and protects a developing fetus in the uterus. Researches have identified stem cells in samples of amniotic fluid drawn from pregnant women for testing or treatment a procedure called amniocentesis. The embryos being used in embryonic stem cell research come from eggs that were fertilized at invitro fertilization clinics but never implanted in women's uteruses. The stem cells are donated with informed consent from donors. The stem cells can live and grow in special solutions in test tubes or petridish in laboratories.

Stem cell therapy, also known as regenerative medicine, promotes the repair response of diseased, dysfunctional or injured tissue using stem cells or their derivatives. It is the next level in organ transplantation and uses cells instead of donor organs, which are limited in supply. Researchers grow stem cells in a lab. These stem cells are manipulated to specialize into specific type of cells, such as heart muscle cells, blood cells or nerve cells. The specialized cells can be implanted into a person. For example, if the person has heart disease, the cells could be injected into the heart muscle. The healthy transplanted heart muscle cells could then contribute for repairing the injured heart muscle. Doctors have performed stem cell transplants, also known as bone marrow transplants. In stem cell transplants, stem cells replace cells damaged by chemotherapy or disease or serve as a way for the donor's immune system to fight some types of cancer and blood-related diseases, such as leukemia, lymphoma, neuroblastoma and multiple myeloma. These transplants use adult stem cells or umbilical cord blood.

Therapeutic cloning, also called somatic cell nuclear transfer, is a technique to create versatile stem cells independent of fertilized eggs. In this technique, the nucleus is removed from an unfertilized egg. This nucleus contains the genetic material. The nucleus is also removed from the cells of a donor. This donor nucleus is then injected into the egg replacing the nucleus that was removed, in a process called nuclear transfer. The egg is allowed to divide and soon forms a blast cyst. This process creates a line of stem cells that is genetically identical to the donor's cells in essence, a clone. Some researchers believe that stem cells derived from therapeutic cloning may offer benefits over those from fertilized eggs because cloned cells are less are less likely to be rejected once transplanted back into the donor's body and may allow researchers to see exactly how a disease develops.

Researchers haven't been able to successfully perform therapeutic cloning with humans despite success in a number of other species. However, in recent studies, researchers have created human pluripotent stem cells by modifying the therapeutic cloning process. Scientists continue to study the potential of therapeutic cloning in people.

Einstein proposed that, the faster you move through space, slower the time ticks for you.

Twin Theory:

A 5 year old twins one stays on Earth, the other travels constantly in a space shuttle and reaches Earth after 10 years. The one who stayed on Earth will be 15 years old, but the one who came back from space will be nearly 7 to 8 years old/younger than the other who stayed on Earth.

This is how time is relative. If a particle travels at the speed of light, time doesn't exist for it. That particle would be able to see the future of the whole universe.

ARE YOU A FRIEND OF SEA TURTLES?



Sea turtle conservation in India started with turtle
walks in Madras (now Chennai) on the east coast in
the early 1970s. In 1988, the Students Sea Turtle
Conservation Network (SSTCN) was formed
and run conservation programmed centered on its sea
turtle hatchery in Besant Nagar beach. The Olive
Ridley turtle's species is recognized as Vulnerable by
the IUCN Red list. The biggest threat to all turtles is
the use of trawlers, which are large fishing vessels
that have huge nets which gather everything in their

path. When they move towards land, they lose all their energy and get dehydrated when the sun
comes up, or are eaten by other animals, or even get run over by vehicles when there are roads next
to beaches. Olive Ridley turtles nest on our Chennai beaches at night, between January and April
every year. During this season students, researchers, scientists and even public patrol the beaches
every night along with Forest Department staff looking for their eggs to collect and relocate into a
Forest Department hatchery. On Friday nights and Saturday nights this network conduct a walk for
the interested people. The turtle walk starts from Neelangarai to Besant Nagar beach to aid the
endangered Olive Ridley sea turtle by relocating eggs for safe release to the sea. It's time to realize
the future of the ocean is in our hands.

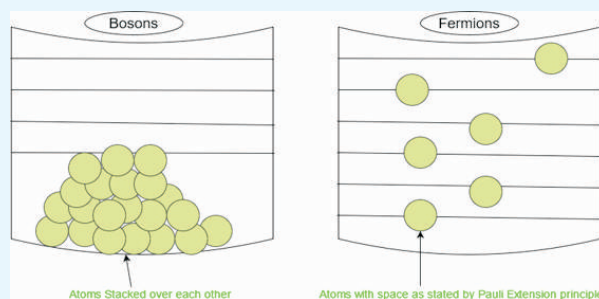

THE FIFTH STATE BOSE EINSTEIN CONDENSATE [BEC]

We are very familiar with the term matter. Everything around us can be considered as a matter. Generally, it's misconceived that the study of matter only involves three states of it which are solid, liquid, and gaseous. But, matter does exist in other forms of states in nature besides these three, matter that include Plasma and Bose-Einstein Condensate.

In 1925 Einstein predicted that at low temperatures particles in a gas could all reside in the same quantum state. This peculiar gaseous state, a Bose Einstein condensate (BEC) is a state of matter of a dilute gas of bosons cooled to temperatures very close to absolute zero. Under such conditions, a large fraction of bosons occupy the lowest quantum state at which point microscopic quantum phenomena, particularly wave function interference, And, it was produced in the laboratory for the first time in 1995 using the powerful laser-cooling methods developed in recent years. These condensates exhibit quantum phenomena on a large scale, and investigating them has become one of the most active areas in contemporary physics.

BoseEinstein condensates in dilute atomic gases, which were first realized experimentally in 1995 for rubidium [1], sodium [2], and lithium [3], provide unique opportunities for exploring quantum phenomena on a macroscopic scale.
