5 ALLEN NEET/IIT JEE

The school has launched integrated coaching program for NEET and IIT aspirant to maximize their potential and to achieve their goal. The school tied up with Allen career and expert faculty from IIT train the students of class IX - XII for entrance exam and competitive exams within school hours.15 hours of coaching per week in core subjects such as Physics, Chemistry, Maths , Biology & Mental ability. They are assessed every fortnight. 39 students have joined pre-medical coaching, 28 students have joined IIT-JEE & 20 students in foundation course. This program is running smoothly along with CBSE curriculum.

12 PROGRAMMES

In order to improve the English language proficiency, Listening and speaking skill among the students we are conducting various programmes.

12(i) ENGLISH LAB:

To develop the listening and learning skills for students, English lab was renovated.

The Lab avails one to one communication system connected with a mentor system. The advantage of updated Lab includes various English study materials, mock tests, individual mentoring sessions, and personality development to boost the performance of students to the next level.

12(ii) GRADED EXAMINATION IN SPOKEN ENGLISH (GESE)

Communicating effectively is the key to success in the 21st century. To empower the English language and to broadening Language horizon, this is the 5th year, our school collaborated with TRINITY COLLEGE, LONDON to prepare students for Graded Examination in spoken English, i.e. GESE, one - to - one/ face – to – face assessments to develop the Listening and speaking skill of our students. This will be more valuable for the students to develop their communicating ability.

12(iii) ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY AWARDS

Spoken language of all the classes are continuously monitored by the teachers and the classes which speaks Eloquent English is honored with 'Eloquent English Laureates' award every month.

12(iv) RAPACIOUS READER AWARD

For the betterment and improvisation of English reading skills, a monthly reading assessment has been conducted from class I to V. The children with good reading skills including the pronunciation and intonation were honored with "Rapacious Reader" Badge which is a rotational honour.

13 REMEDIAL CLASSES

In order to help the students whose parents are not in a position to help them in studies at home for such students special coaching classes are being conducted on all Saturdays from 09.00 AM to 12.30 PM. After Result analysis of PT-I, slow learners in various subjects are identified. For their Remedial classes have been started in Maths & Science subjects.

To supplement the studies we have a huge library comprising more than 11,502 books cost Rs.2172984 which gets stacked regularly with the latest editions. Library period is allocated from classes III to XII in the time table to inculcate the reading habit.
